

FOLBB declaration about the EUDR

The FOLBB Group – **Baiersbronn Frischfaser Karton GmbH and Folding Boxboard Eerbeek B.V.** – is fully aware of the EU Deforestation Regulation which will extend the EU Timber Regulation end of 2025 – beginning of 2026.

FOLBB strongly supports efforts and initiatives contributing to ban deforestation around the globe. In all its policies and procedures FOLBB is committed to zero deforestation. While the current EUTR focuses on timber products, the range of products have been extended with upcoming EUDR. Based on our quality manual, we can confirm that we already comply with the EU Timber regulation.

FOLBB EUDR Compliance Status & Commitment

- **Current Status**

FOLBB complies with the existing EU Timber Regulation (EUTR) and operates under FSC® (CU-COC-888212) and PEFC (CU-PEFC-COC-888212) Chain of Custody certifications. These systems guarantee that all virgin fibre used in our cartonboard originates from legal, sustainable, and traceable sources, ensuring no contribution to illegal deforestation.

- **Declaration of Timber Origin**

Fibre used in our production is sourced from the EU27, Norway, Switzerland, Uruguay, and Brazil, including species such as spruce, pine, eucalyptus, fir, larch, birch, and others. A traceable declaration of origin is maintained and updated annually.

- **Conversion-Free & Deforestation-Free Assurance**

FOLBB is committed to maintaining a conversion-free supply chain, meaning that our fibre inputs do not originate from recently converted natural ecosystems (e.g., forests to plantations or croplands). We aim to meet this through a combination of certification, supplier due diligence, and internal controls.

- **Implementation Timeline**

FOLBB is currently updating its internal systems and processes to align fully with EUDR requirements, including traceability to plot level, due diligence statements, and geo-location data.

We aim to be fully EUDR-compliant by Q4 2025, in line with the expectations of our customers and the EU timeline.
